Mrs. Wieland, Belleville, Dies; Rites Tuesday

BELLEVILLE—Mrs. Fred Wieland, 48, a Green county resident for 24 years, died early Saturday at her farm home near here after a two months' illness.

She was born in Switzerland and came to Juda in this country in 1915 with her husband. Mrs. Wieland belonged to the G. U. G. G., a German organization, in Monroe.
