Area Cheesemaker Many Years Dies at Age of 60

Gottfried Winiger, 60 years of age and well known to many of the older residents of this community, who has been engaged at the cheesemaking trade near Blanchardville, passed away Sunday in the Monroe hospital after undergoing an operation.

Mr. Winiger was born in Rothkreuz, Canton Zug, Switzerland, and came to Dane county, Wisconsin in 1905. He was employed in cheese factories in this area for many years, the latest being the Indian Hill factory near Blanchardville.

Survivors include two brothers, John, Prairie du Sac and formerly of Monticello, and Joseph, Monroe, and a sister in Switzerland.

Funeral services were held Tuesday at 9 a. m. in the Stuessy funeral home, Monroe, and at 9:30 at St. Victor's Catholic church, the Rev. Fr. Boniface officiating. Burial was in Calvary cemetery, Monroe,

The rosary was recited at 8:30 p.m. Monday in the Stuessy funeral home.
