

## **Edwin P. Wirth**

**Oct. 28, 1935 - Dec. 25, 1991**

Edwin P. Wirth, 56, Madison, died Wednesday, Dec. 25, 1991, at Countryside Home, Jefferson.

He was born Oct. 28, 1935 in Exeter Township, the son of John and Leonia May (Staley) Wirth.

He was a 1953 graduate of Monticello High School and graduated from the UW-Madison with a degree in music in 1957.

He was a reservation agent for North Central Airlines, a buyer for Sears in Chicago, and taught music privately in Chicago.

He was a Sergeant in the United State Army and served from Oct. 18, 1957, to Oct. 12, 1960. He was in Germany for 27 months with the Headquarters and Headquarter Detachment Band, 24th Infantry Division Trains APO and was discharged at Fort Dixon, NJ.

Survivors include two brothers, John and Walter, both of Monticello; and three sisters, Mrs. Viola (Robert) Holcomb, Monticello, Mrs. Mabel (Ralph) Zimmerman, Madison, and Mrs. Nellie (Harlan) Babler, New Glarus.
