Rites Held Friday for Albert Witt, Age 81, Retired Area Farmer

Funeral services for Albert F. Witt, 81 years of age, prominent retired Mt, Pleasant township farmer, who died early last Wednesday morning at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where he had been a patient since Monday, were held at 2 p.m. Friday at the Evangelical United Brethren church here.

The Rev. B. L. Holling, Monroe, church pastor, officiated, and interment was in the Dutch Hollow cemetery. Pallbearers were Willis Babler, John Wittwer and Louise Wyss, Monticello, William Ienatsch, Barneveld, Fritz Schild and Orville L. White, Monroe.

Mr. Witt had been in failing health the past three years and a heart condition was the cause of his death.

He was born in Sylvester township on Oct. 23, 1882. He was united to Bess Schultz Feb. 5, 1908, at the home of her parents, who operated the Schultz Siding store, about four and one-half miles south of Monticello. The couple farmed near there in Mt. Pleasant township, where his grandson, Paul Witt, now lives. They retired and moved to the former Schultz home in 1935.

Mr. Witt was an active member of the former Dutch Hollow church.

He is survived by his wife: one son, Lester A. Witt, Route 4, Monroe; one brother, Harry, Ramona, S. D.; five grandchildren, Paul, Don, Richard, Beverly and Karen Witt, and seven great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by one brother, Otto, and several half-brothers and half-sisters.
