### **Ernest Wittwer, Monticello, Dies**

MONTICELLO (Times Special) — Ernest Wittwer, 75, of Monticello, died yesterday of a heart condition at St. Mary's hospital, Kansas City, Mo., where he and his wife were spending the holidays with their son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. George Jones. He was admitted to the hospital shortly after arriving in Kansas City.

Mr. Wittwer was born in Postville, Oct. 18, 1885. He married the former Harriet Reese, Jan. 29, 1908, in Redfield, S. D., where they made their home for the next nine years. In 1917, the Wittwers moved to Madison and in 1940 came to Monticello. Mr. Wittwer operated a cheese store.

Surviving, besides his wife and daughter, are two sons, Jack, Kansas City, and George E., Madison; one sister, Mrs. Lee Dawley, Olympia, Wash., and seven grandchildren. He was preceded in death by one sister, Mrs. Rowlie A. Baxter, in July, 1953.

Services will be Tuesday at 2 p.m. in the Voegeli funeral home. Rev. J. Allan Mittler of Zwingli United Church of Christ will officiate. Burial will be in Highland cemetery.
