Rites Held Tuesday For Edgar Wright

Funeral services for Edgar B. Wright, 53 years of age, a native of Monticello, who passed away last Thursday afternoon in his home at Maywood, Ill., a suburb of Chicago, were held at 2 p. m. Tuesday at the Schroeder funeral home, Madison.

Burial was in Roselawn Memorial Park, Monona.

Mr. Wright had been seriously ill for a number of weeks and had been hospitalized for some time.

The son of Arthur and Sally Brayton Wright, he was born in Monticello and graduated from the Monticello high school in 1919. He had been employed by the Milwaukee Road in various capacities for 32 years. In recent years he was an auditor for the railroad and lived in Madison for about eight years. His father, who retired last summer, had been connected with the Milwaukee Road for 57 years, first as traveling auditor and for many years as station agent.
