Christ Yaussi, 95, Monticello, died at 4:15 pm. Thursday, April 21, 1983, in Pleasant View Nursing Home. He had been a resident there since June 12, 1978, following hospitalization.

He was born on the Yaussi homestead farm in Washington Township, Green County, May 19, 1887, to Emmanuel and Maria Bruni Yaussi, and attended Marty Rural School in Washington Township. He Was married to Hattie Wyss Feb. 4, 1915, in Monroe by the late Rev. P. A. Schuh.

They farmed in Washington Township until moving to Monticello in 1942. He then was employed as a patrolman for the Green County Highway Department for 15 years, retiring in 1957.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Hilda McFann, Chico, Calif., and Mrs. Elaine Teuscher of Monticello; five grandchildren, nine great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren.

Preceding him in death were his parents, his wife, in 1953; a brother, Fred, and four sisters, Mrs. Emma Wiesenberg, Mrs. Mary Wiesenberg, Mrs. Rose O'Brien and Miss Anna Yaussi.

The deceased was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and former member of the Washington Reformation Church. An outdoorsman, he was especially fond of hunting.

Private memorial services will be held at 1:30 pm. Saturday, April 23, in Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge. There will be no visitation. Interment services will take place Monday, April 25, in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
