MONTICELLO—Charles Youngreen, 71, Monticello, died Wednesday at a Madison hospital, where he had been for three weeks.

Mr. Youngreen was born in Glasgow, Scotland, and came to Duluth, Minn., with his family when 14. He moved to Belvedere, Ill., and worked for the Borden Co., with which he was associated for 32 years, coming to the Monticello plant in 1918. He worked for the Pet Milk Co. for nine years after it took over the plant, then operated a tavern. He was married at Belvedere in 1907 to Bessie Peterson. He was a Mason, a member of the Order of Eastern Star, and of Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

Survivors include his wife; a son, Capt. Harold, a doctor in an army hospital on New Britain; a daughter, Mrs. Matt Zentner, Monticello, and a grandson.

The body will be at the Voegeli funeral home until Saturday noon, when it will be taken to the Evangelical and Reformed church, where services will be held at 2. p.m. The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier will officiate. Masonic services will be held at the grave in Highland cemetery.
