

John P. Zentner
Jan. 1, 1893 - April 25, 1964

Dr. John P. Zentner, 71 years of age, native of the Monticello area, who practiced dentistry here for several years before locating in Milwaukee, died Saturday in a Milwaukee hospital where he had been a patient for 10 days. He had been ill for some time.

Funeral services were held at 1:30: Tuesday afternoon in the Prasser funeral home, Milwaukee, with Masonic rites. Burial was in Arlington Park cemetery.

Dr. Zentner was born Jan. 1, 1893, near Monticello, the son of Oswald and Euphemia Stauffacher Zentner. He attended the Zentner rural school and graduated from the Monroe high school. He graduated from Marquette University Dental School and opened a practice in Monticello. In 1927 he sold his practice here to Dr. William V. Baebler and moved to Milwaukee. He retired from his Milwaukee practice several years ago.

He is survived by his wife, the former Amanda Budzien; a son, Robert John, in Maryland, and three grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Mrs. J. M. Freitag, Jan, 28, 1938, and two brothers, Oswald, Dec, 12, 1950, and Dietrick (Dick), Aug. 30, 1959.
