Armin Gabriell Zingere Feb. 10, 1900 - April 14, 1974

Armin Gabriell Zingere, 74, was dead Sunday evening, April 14, in his Riverview Apartment in Albany. Death was due to natural causes according to Coroner Richard Wagner and no inquest will be held.
