

Eugene L. “Dutch” Zoller

Eugene L. “Dutch” Zoller, age 70, of Monroe, died suddenly on Saturday, November 25, 2000 at University Hospital, Madison.

Eugene was born July 9, 1930 in St. Nickolas, Minnesota, the son of Ludwig and Adelaide (Post) Zoller. He attended Postville rural school and graduated from Monroe High School in 1949. He entered the US. Army on Sept. 9, 1953 in Milwaukee. He was a Heavy Vehicle Driver and earned the National Defense Service Medal and Army of Occupation Medal. He was honorably discharged on August 17, 1955 at Fort . Sheridan, IL. Gene farmed in the Green County area and worked for many years as a cheesemaker at Lugano Cheese and Milwaukee Cheese Companies of Monroe. Following his retirement, Gene worked part time for Monroe Superwash, Greenwood Cemetery, and the Swiss Colony.



He was a member of Washington Reformation United Church of Christ, Monticello, and Monticello American Legion Amstutz-Marty Post #256.
