Zane Zor Zurbuchen, 52, Monticello, died Sunday, Dec. 24, 1989, in St. Clare Hospital, Monroe.

Born May 2, 1937, in Monroe, he was the son of Theophil J. and Minnie Merlee (Pickett) Zurbuchen. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1955.
