John Zurfluh, Age 72, Mt. Pleasant, Dies

John Zurfluh, years of age, prominent farmer residing about six miles east of Monticello, passed away at 9:30 a. m. Monday at his home. He had been ill the past several months with a heart condition.

A native of Bern, Switzerland, he was born June 26, 1885, the son of Melchior and Kathryn Beiri Zurfluh, and came to America with his parents when he was seven years of age. He was united in marriage to Elsie Legler on June 29, 1911, and they lived in the Browntown area before moving to their present farm in 1916.

Mr. Zurfluh was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

He is survived by his wife; five sons, Fred, Louis, John and Willis, all of the Albany area, and Robert, with the U. S. Navy; four daughters, Mrs. Henry Spring, Monticello, Mrs. John Robinson, Powersville, Mo., Mrs. Charles Briggs, Albany, and Mrs. Fred Beer, Jr., Monroe; one brother, Adolph Zurfluh, Brodhead; three sisters, Mr. Jack Legler, Dodgeville, Mrs. Sam Nafzger, Alton, Texas, and Mrs. Emil Boesch, of Monroe; 24 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Funeral arrangements are pending word from the son in service.
