Homer Zweifel, 42, Local Native, Dies

Homer E. Zweifel, 42 years of age, Montello; a native of Monticello, died at his home in Montello of a heart attack on Tuesday of last week. Funeral services were held at Montello at 9 a. m. Friday. Additional services were held in New Glarus at 2 p. m. Friday in the Swiss Evangelical and Reformed church, with the Rev. Lynn F. B. Tschudy officiating.
