

Sarah Louise Zweifel
Nov. 2, 1867 – April 19, 1955
Mrs. Louise Zweifel Dies in Oklahoma

Mrs. Sarah Louise Zweifel, 87 years of age, a native of Monticello, but who had lived in Oklahoma for many years, died April 19 in an Oklahoma City hospital following a stroke three weeks previously.

Rites and burial were held in Shawnee, Okla.

Sarah Louise Jenny was born in Mt. Pleasant township Nov. 2, 1867. She married Jost Zweifel and the couple moved to Shawnee, Okla. in 1903. Mr. Zweifel died Jan. 3, 1933.

Mrs. Zweifel was a member of the Lutheran church.
