LONG DISTANCE SERVICE

Analyse whether your Long Distance calls should be placed as STATION-TO-STATION, or PERSON-TO-PERSON calls. Save money by studying your requirements, and indicate the classification when you place your call.

Proper Way to Place a STATION-TO-STATION CALL

This is a Station-to-Station call. 131 John Smith calling Madison, Wisconsin. I wish to talk with anyone at Badger 1650. (State name of residence, or firm if telephone number is not known.)

Proper Way to Place a PFRSON-TO-PFRSON CALL

This is a Person-to-Person call. 131 John Smith calling Madison, Wisconsin. I wish to talk with Richard Clark, Badger 1650. (State address, or firm name if known.)

Station-to-Station Service

A Station-to-Station call assumes the lowest rate as the party placing such a call is willing to talk with anyone who answers the telephone.

On Station-to-Station calls only, there are evening and night rates.

Evening—Between 8:30 p. m. and 12 Midnight one-half of the day rate.

Night—Between 12 Midnight and 4:30 a.m. one-fourth of the day rate.

Minimum "Evening" or "Night" rate, 25 cents.

Person-to-Person Service

When a long distance call is placed for a particular individual, every reasonable effort will be put forth to get that party to the telephone.

This is a person-to-person call and is accepted at a rate about 25% greater than a Station-to-Station call.

Report Charge

Orders for Person-to-Person service are accepted only under the condition that a limited charge known as a "Report Charge" will be paid in the event that the call is not completed any time before midnight of the day it is placed. A charge is not made when the telephone does not answer, is out of order, or no report is given the patron within an hour after the call is placed.

This charge is made to cover the circuit time consumed, and the Operators' time used in trying to get the party.

All Collect calls assume a Person-to-Person rate.

Appointment and Messenger calls are subject to a rate about one-half greater than a Stationto-Station call.

Toll will be charged to the telephone used and collected at the end of the month.

IF YOU VALUE GOOD SERVICE

Call by number always.

Don't rely on your memory.

Refer to your directory each time before you place a call.

Answer your telephone promptly.

Answer it thus: "John Smith speaking," or "Brown & Co." Talk clearly and close to the mouth piece.

Limit your conversations to five minutes.

Often you fail to get important calls because your line is reported busy. Please remember it is not the fault of the operator if she must give this report about your telephone. It requires less time on her part to establish a connection.

Report trouble and matters pertaining to the service to the Manager, telephone No. 18.

The regular hours for service are from 6 a. m. to 10 p. m. We handle emergency calls during the night. Do not construe ordinary business or social calls as emergency.

The telephone company reserves the privilege of changing numbers, and assumes no responsibility for errors or omissions in the directory.
