

## **Gustof Peter Adamson**

**Nov. 9, 1912 - June 17, 1985**

Gus Adamson, 72, Monticello, died Monday, June 17, 1985 in Pleasant View Nursing Home. Death resulted from a cardiac arrest suffered six weeks ago. He was a patient at the nursing home for the past three weeks, after his dismissal from St. Clare Hospital, Monroe.

He was born in Anoka, Neb., Nov. 9, 1912, the son of John and Florence (Cute) Adamson. He graduated from Butte High School in Nebraska. He married the former Veryl F. Stanford Nov. 30, 1933, in Burwell, Neb.

They operated a ranch in Springview, Neb., until moving to rural Brodhead in the spring of 1942 and retired to Monticello in 1978.

He was an active member of Calvary Temple, Monroe, having been an adult Sunday School teacher and member of the deacon's board for many years. He was a member of the Green County Farm Bureau.

Surviving are his wife, Veryl; two sons, Verlyn Adamson of New Glarus and Peter of Waxahachie, Texas; one daughter, Mrs. James (Myrna) Brown, Buford, Ga.; 11 grandchildren, a brother, Dean, Los Angeles, Calif. and a sister, Mrs. Vance (Arline) Clark, Chappell, Neb.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a son, Donald, on Aug. 10, 1972; a brother, John, and a sister, Florence Thurber.

Funeral rites will be held at 12:30 p. m. Friday at Calvary Temple. The Rev. Bob Bohn will officiate. Interment will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
