Elizabeth Altmann Expires in Madison Illness of Nearly a Year Proves Fatal to Local Girl

Miss Elizabeth Barbara Altmann, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Altmann, living a mile north of Monticello, passed away at an early hour yesterday morning after an illness of about a year's duration. Her death occurred at the Wisconsin General hospital, Madison, where she was under treatment for an anemic condition.

About a year ago Miss Altmann was a patient for several weeks at the Methodist hospital, Madison, and her condition was much improved when she was eventually dismissed from the institution. The treatment she received at that time, however, failed to prove of lasting benefit and her condition of late again assumed a serious turn.

Miss Altmann was born June 11, 1918, at the family home north of the village and would have reached her 18th birthday anniversary had she lived until today. She was a student in the local high school when first stricken with the malady and had always been much thought of by the student body and the faculty in general.

Surviving, besides the parents, is one sister, Dorothy, and her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Altmann, Monroe, and Mr. and Mrs. Peter Steiner, New Glarus.
