Mrs. Jacob Altmann, Monroe, Summoned Conduct Final Services for Aged County Seat Resident

Funeral services for Mrs. Jacob Altmann, 71 years of age, life-long Green county resident, who passed away in her home in Monroe at about 6 o'clock Thursday evening from pneumonia which she contracted shortly after the first of the year, were held at 1:30 Monday afternoon in the home for the family and at 2 in St. John's Evangelical church, Monroe.

Rev. Paul C, Kehle, church pastor, officiated. Burial was in Highland cemetery, Monticello. Pallbearers were: Peter Kubly, Claude A. Roderick, Fred and Carl Wyss, Walter Freitag and Willis Duerst, Monroe.

Born in New Glarus

Margaret Marty was born in New Glarus Jan. 7, 1868, a daughter of John and Elsbeth Heer Marty. She was united in marriage to Jacob Altmann, the ceremony taking place in Monticello Dec. 8, 1892. The couple followed the vocation of farming and for a time they conducted a farm in Washington township. Subsequently they moved to a farm in Mt. Pleasant township, a short distance north of Monticello, now conducted by a son, Fred. In 1917 they moved to Monroe.

Survivors are the husband, four sons, Fred, Monticello; Theodore, William and Henry, Monroe; two daughters, Mrs. Albert Heinzelman, Monroe, and Mrs. Robert Wyss, Sylvester township; seven brothers, Henry, Nicholas, John, Theodore, Casper and Jacob Marty, New Glarus, and Matthias, Washington township; one sister, Mrs. Casper Schneider, New Glarus; and seven grandchildren, She was preceded in death by her parents, two sons, one daughter, one sister, two brothers, and granddaughter, Miss Elizabeth Altmann, who passed away in 1936 at the age of 17.
