Albert D. Babler Sr., age 82, of Monticello, died Monday, April 16, 2007 at the Monroe Clinic Hospital. Albert was born July 23, 1924 in Green County, Wisconsin, the son of Glen J. Babler and Louise E. (Legler) Freitag.
