Mrs. Anna K. Babler, 98. former long-time Monticello rural school teacher, died on Tuesday, Dec. 27, 1983, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, where she had resided since Feb. 10 1981, following a short illness.

She was born on Feb. 5, 1885, in a log cabin in Exeter Township, Green County, the daughter of David and Anna Zweifel Klassy. She was married in Rockford, Ill., on April 16, 1907 to Ezra A. Babler. He died in May 1909.

She Was a lifelong Monticello resident. She taught rural schools for a total of 40 years beginning her teaching career at the Elmer School in Mount Pleasant Township. She also taught at Dutch Hollow School, Marty and Klassy schools and the Simmons School near Monticello, where she last taught, retiring in 1958.
