MRS. BABLER STRICKEN AT 92

Mrs. Henry Babler Sr., 92 a former resident of Monticello, died at 4:30 p. m. Thursday, July 24, in the home of her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. J. F. Freitag, 1120 19th St., Monroe. She had made her home with the Freitags the past four years.

Mrs. Babler had been bedfast the past five weeks from old-age complications.

The former Anna Losenegger was born in Schwartznick, Switzerland, Jan. 14, 1877, a daughter of John and Anna Bieri Losenegger. She came to the United States, settling in Green Country, in March 1893. She was married Sept. 19, 1895 at Monticello to Henry Babler.

They farmed south of that village, in Mt. Pleasant Township, until about 1902, moving then to Monticello, Mr. Babler died March 21, 1915.

Mrs. Babler had remained active through her latter years. While in Monticello she continued to garden and do her outside yard work.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ at Monticello.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Freitag, Monroe, and Mrs. R. J. Theiler, Madison; two sons, Clarence, Richland Center, and Herman, Monticello; a stepson, J. B. Babler, Monroe; five grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by a son, Marvin, Appleton, in December 1953; three stepsons, Henry E., Fred and Ezra Babler, all of Monticello, and two step-daughters, Mrs. Fred C. Marty, Monticello and Mrs. Ed Kelling, Goldfield, Ia.; four sisters and four brothers, one brother died in Mt. Horeb and the other three in Switzerland.

Funeral services will be at 2 p. m. Sunday, July 27, in the Zwingli Church in Monticello. Rev. J. Allan Mittler is to officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
