Bernice M. Babler, age 93. Belleville died Saturday, December 22, 2001, at the Monroe Clinic Hospital. Bernice was born April 18, 1908, in Mount Pleasant Township, Green County, the daughter of Henry E. and Rose (Zimmerman) Babler. She graduated from Monticello High School in 1926 and received a Bachelor of Science degree in Education from Stevens Point Teacher College in 1960.
