Mrs. H. L. Babler Passes On

Death Takes Place Unexpectedly At Madison Hospital

A stroke of apoplexy was responsible for the unexpected death shortly after noon yesterday of Mrs. H. L. Babler, 64, at the Methodist hospital, Madison.

She had undergone a successful goiter operation Tuesday afternoon and every indication pointed to her recovery. She rested well through the night Tuesday and it not until yesterday morning around 7 o'clock when her daughter, Mrs. R. H. Schoonover, who had been with her almost constantly since entering the hospital, had gone out for breakfast, that her condition became serious. Mrs. Schoonover was immediately called to the hospital.

Mrs. Babler was rendered unconscious by the stroke and remained so until the end. The members of her immediate family were at her bedside, H. L. Babler, her husband, and the two sons, H. O. Babler, Monticello, and W. E. Babler, Beaver Dam, having been called when the unfavorable turn in her condition came.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home and a half hour later in the church. Interment will be in Highland cemetery.

All business places will be closed during the funeral.
