

## **Elizabeth Baebler**

### **Mrs. Baebler, Age 74, Mt. Pleasant Twp. Resident, Succumbs - 1958**

Mrs. Elizabeth Baebler, 74 years of age, native of Monticello and a resident of Mt. Pleasant township for many years, passed away at her farm home, two miles east of Monticello, at 9:45 p. m. Tuesday after a long illness.

Mrs. Baebler had been hospitalized for a month and returned to her home June 13.

The daughter of John and Katherine Rhyner Bryner, she was born in Monticello May 24, 1884. The family moved to Humbird, where she attended school. She was united in marriage there on Dec. 26, 1901, to Vinzenz Baebler. Since her marriage she had always lived on the Baebler farm which is operated by a son, Alvin.
