

Emma B. Bagley
February 19, 1891 - January 25, 1976

Funeral services for Mrs. Emma B. Bagley, 84, of 303 Vinton St., Albany, were held at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday, January 28, at the Gohlke's Sharer Funeral Home, Albany.

Mrs. Bagley died January 25, at 11:20 at St. Clare Hospital, Monroe. She was born in Monticello on February 19, 1891, the daughter of Henry and Ursula Blumer Freitag. She attended school in Monticello and furthered her education at Green County Normal School.

On February 12, 1914, she was married in Monticello to Burr L. Bagley. He died on March 1, 1956. Mrs. Bagley lived in the Monticello and Albany areas all her life.
