C. T. Bartlett, 72, Dies Unexpectedly

Final rites for Chauncey Bartlett, aged 72, well known and lifelong resident of Attica, several miles east of Monticello, who passed away Thursday afternoon in the office of an Albany physician after he was stricken with a heart attack while climbing the stairs to the office, were conducted at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon in the Attica Methodist church. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Bartlett was a native of Attica where he was born on Oct. 1, 1857, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Bartlett. His marriage to Miss Anna Maynard took place at Albany on Jan. 29, 1879. Mr. Bartlett was a carpenter and contractor by trade. He was affiliated with the Albany Woodmen and Masonic lodges.
