

**Ernest Brunner**  
**July 1, 1905 - Feb. 21, 1993**

Ernest Brunner, 87, formerly of Harmony Manor, Monroe, died Sunday, Feb. 21, 1993 in Pleasant View Nursing Home.

He was born July 1, 1905 in Oberried, Switzerland, Canton of Bern, the son of Arnold and Ida (Amacher) Brunner.

He attended Round Grove Rural School.

He married Lorraine Crouch Oct. 17, 1929 at St. John's United Church of Christ. She died Nov. 10, 1982. He worked on the road crews for the county and farmed in Monroe and Washington townships until moving to Monroe in 1987.

He was a member of Washington Reformation Church and Green County farm Bureau.

Survivors include a son, Ralph, on the home farm; two brothers, Jack, Jefferson, and Werner, Madison; a sister, Mrs. Arthur (Margaret) Holcomb, Monroe; six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a daughter, Nancy Schwartzlow, in 1987; and two brothers, Arnold and Adolph Brunner.

Funeral services were held Wednesday in Washington Reformation Church, the Rev. David Voll officiating, burial is in the church cemetery.
