

## **Loraine Brunner**

Mrs. Ernest (Loraine) Brunner, 75, rural Monroe, died Nov. 10, 1982, in St. Clare Hospital, Monroe, where she had been admitted Nov. 3 as a medical patient.

She was the former Loraine Crouch, and was born in Washington Township on Oct. 5, 1907, the daughter of Josiah and Anna Disch Crouch. She attended the Loveland rural school and graduated from the Green County Normal School in Monroe. She taught rural school for one year.

On Oct. 17, 1929, she was married to Ernest Brunner in St. John's Church, Monroe. They farmed in the Washington Township area where they resided since their marriage.

She was a member of the Washington Reformation Church, where funeral services were held on Saturday, Nov. 13. Rev. Steve Pederson officiated and burial was in the church cemetery.

Survivors are her husband, Ernest; one son, Ralph Brunner, rural Monroe; two brothers, Josiah Crouch Jr. and Albert Crouch, both of Monticello; six grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
