Werner Brunner, age 92 of Woodruff, WI formerly of New Glarus died September 11, 2008 at the Seasons of Life Hospice House in Woodruff.

Werner was born December 14, 1915 in Monroe, WI, the son of Arnold and Ida (Amacher) Brunner. Shortly after graduating from Monticello High School he joined the Civilian Conservation Corps where he worked on drought relief projects during 1934-1935, and later attended Milwaukee School of Engineering. Werner and Freda S. Hefty were married on September 3, 1937 in Monticello. She preceded him in death on November 16, 2003. Werner and his wife owned several businesses in Wisconsin, most recently Breslers 33 Flavors Ice Cream of Madison.

He was a former member of the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus and Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello,

He is survived by his son, Eric (Christine) Brunner of Eagle River, WI.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Margaret Holcomb; and four brothers, Arnold, Ernest, Adolph, and Jacob Brunner.
