Mr. Roland C. "Bucky" Buchholz, age 66, Monticello, passed away on Wednesday, May 8, 2002 at University Hospital, Madison. Bucky was born on Dec. 25, 1935, in Wilton. The son of Carl and Leona (Summerfield) Buchholz. He was a graduate of Wilton High School, LaCrosse State Teachers College and UW-Platteville where he received a Masters Degree in Education.
