Funeral Services Held For Mrs. Barbara Burgy, 87

Funeral services for Mrs. Barbara Burgy, 87 years old, Monroe, mother of Jacob Burgy, Monticello, who died early Thursday morning after having sustained a broken hip on the preceding forenoon, were held at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon in the home of her daughter, Mrs. John Duebendorfer, Monroe.

The services were conducted by her pastor, Rev. P. A. Schuh, of the St. John's Evangelical church, assisted by Rev. G. H. Blum, pastor of the Immanuel Evangelical church,

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Luchsinger, Mrs. Burgy was born Jan. 23, 1842, in Canton of Glarus, Switzerland. The Luchsinger family came to America in 1845, settling in Philadelphia and then locating at New Glarus 11 years later.

On July 1, 1858, she was united in marriage to Jacob Burgy at the age of 16. The couple resided on a farm near New Glarus until 1872, when the family moved onto the farm, southwest of Monticello, now owned and conducted by the son, Jacob Burgy. Here they resided until 1891 when they moved to Monroe. Mr. Burgy's death took place in that city in February, 1893.

Survivors are one son, Jacob, Monticello, and six daughters, Mrs. John Duebendorfer, Mrs. Emery A. Odell, and Mrs. J. Jacob Tschudy, Monroe; Mrs. A. J. Magoon, Kilbourn, Mrs. J. B. Pierce, Brodhead, and Mrs. Fred M. Burke, Walnut, Ill.
