

William Carroll, Sr.
May 1, 1858 – Jan. 5, 1934

Albany — Funeral services for William Carroll, Sr., 75, who died Friday night in his home in Mt. Pleasant township, following an attack of pneumonia, were held in the home and in St. James' Catholic church at Dayton Monday morning, Father Lochowitz, of the Belleville Catholic. church, officiating.

Burial was in St. James' Catholic cemetery on the Dayton-Belleville road. Mr. Carroll was born on the Carroll homestead in Mt. Pleasant, May 1, 1858. He married Miss Alice Fitzgerald in Dayton in 1895.

The survivors are the widow; two daughters, Elizabeth and Alice, and a son, William, Jr., all at home, and a third daughter, Mrs. Ray Silver, living near her parents home; a brother, Anthony and a sister, Miss Katheryn Carroll, both of Mt. Pleasant township and a second sister, Miss Alice Carroll of Janesville. A son, Michael, died in infancy.
