Leone L. Loeffel Coplien, age 95 of Monroe formerly Albany, Wisconsin died on Thursday, December 30, 2010 at the Monroe Manor Nursing Home. She was born on November 13, 1915 in Dutch Hollow, Green County, the daughter of John and Martha (Golz) Loeffel. She was a graduate of Monroe High School, Green County Normal School and U.W.
