Albert Crouch, 74, Monroe, Summoned
Last Rites Conducted for Former Washington Resident

Funeral services for Albert Crouch, 74 years of age, native of Washington township, and well known to many residents in the Monticello vicinity, who passed away on Wednesday afternoon of last week in the Deaconess hospital, Monroe, after having been confined there since May 15 with a heart ailment, were conducted at 2:30 Friday afternoon in the Knight & Voelkli funeral home, Monroe.

Rev. Alvin C. Rabehl officiated. Five nephews and one cousin officiated as pallbearers. The nephews are Albert, Cyrus and Nathan Crouch, Washington township, Carl Miller and Ernest Brunner, Monticello, and the cousin, Glen Magee, Evansville.

Mr. Crouch, who was familiarly known to his many friends as "Bert," was born Oct. 21, 1863, the son of Samuel T. and Amelia Crouch. He attended the rural school in his district and later followed the vocation of farming in Washington township, where he resided for many years. He established a large friendship through his many years of stock buying in Monticello and later in Monroe. In 1898 he was married to Christena "Tena" Harper, the ceremony having been conducted in Monroe. She passed away in 1917,

He is survived by one brother, Josiah Crouch, Washington township, and one sister, Mrs. Alma E. Minor, Monroe. He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister and one brother.
