MONTICELLO — Ms. Lora B. Dick passed away after a brief illness on Saturday, July 15, 1995, at Pleasant View nursing Home in Monroe, Wisconsin.

She was born on June 12, 1908, to John and Anna (Messerli) Dick in Monticello, Wisconsin. She graduated from Monticello High School in 1926 and attended Stevens Point Teachers College where she received her B.S. degree. She taught elementary school in Monticello from 1929 until 1960. She later taught in Lompoc, California and Madison's Gompers Elementary School. She retired to Monticello in 1964 where she made her home since. She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello and a member of its church choir for many years. Lora was a popular soloist for many events at the church. She was also a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, was an avid reader, and liked to travel to Switzerland, Norway, Italy and Ireland.

She is survived by two brothers.
