Wilbert J. Dick, age 100, of Monticello, died Sunday, March 3, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe. Wilbert was born November 16, 1895, in Washington Township, Green County, son of John and Anna (Messerli) Dick. He was married to Florence Kubly. She preceded him in death on July 31, 1992.

Wilbert was a 1914 graduate of Monticello High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1918 and his 86th division was the last group to be sent to France prior to the end of World War I.

Wilbert was a long time employee of the People Supply Co., Monticello, and he also operated the Hilltop Chicken Hatchery of Monticello. He later farmed near the village until his retirement.

He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, the New Glarus Masonic Lodge, and a 30 year member of Amstutz-Marty American Legion Post #256 Monticello.

Survivors include a step-son Walter (Naomi) Kubly, Sun Prairie; three step-grandchildren; a brother, Carl, Monticello; and four nieces. He was preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Hilda Karlen and Lora Dick; and a brother, Waldo.
