

## **MADALINE DISCH**

**June 10, 1899 - March 26, 1985**

Mrs. Jacob H. (Madaline) Disch, 85, formerly of Monticello and Janesville, died Tuesday, March 26, 1985 at Pleasant View Nursing Home where she had been a resident since Oct. 21, 1983.

The former Madaline M. Lint was born in Richland County June 10, 1899, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James Lint. She attended Monticello High School. Her marriage to Jacob H. Disch took place Feb. 10, 1917, at Monticello. .

They farmed in Exeter Township until 1945, remaining in the Monticello area. Mr. Disch died Sept. 14, 1975. Mrs. Disch moved to Janesville in 1976 where she lived until entering the nursing home.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Canton (Elsa) Paulson and Mrs. Duane (Arlene) Bosben, both of Janesville; a son, Norman H. Disch, Middleton; a brother, Ted Lint; and four sisters, Mrs. Bernice Tietjen, Mrs. Lesta Stutzinger, Mrs. Iva Ullman and Mrs. Vera Snyder, all of St. Paul, Minn.; 12 grandchildren and 22 great-grandchildren.

Preceding her in death were her husband and two sons, Chester on May 12, 1984, and another in infancy.

Mrs. Disch was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and its Ladies Aid Society and the Wallace Homemakers Club.

Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Thursday in Zwingli United Church, Monticello. The Rev. Don Nelson, interim pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
