

**James F. Dooley**  
**Oct. 21, 1898 - Nov. 20, 1977**

James F. Dooley, 79, Rt. 1, Mt. Pleasant Township, Monticello, died on Sun., Nov. 20, at 10 p.m., in St. Claire Hospital, Monroe. Failing health in the last year, Mr. Dooley was admitted into the hospital on Sat., Nov. 19.

Mr. Dooley was born in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, on the Dooley homestead farm, on Oct. 21, 1898. His father was James and mother was Theresa Rossiter.

Mr. Dooley was a graduate of Monticello High School, class of 1918. He was married on June 20, 1931, in Rockford, Ill., to Kathryn A. Dixon, of Brodhead.

Mr. Dooley was a retired farmer. After his marriage he farmed on the Dooley homestead at Mt. Pleasant Township. After retiring from farming, Mr. Dooley and the late Harry Haddinger built and operated the Monticello Sales Barn for about 10 years, until selling it out to a successor.

Mr. Dooley is survived by his wife, Kathryn; two sisters, Mrs. Theresa Clapper, Janesville, and Mrs. Mary Koepke, Madison; and nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and four brothers: Joseph, Edmund, William and Eugene; and two sisters: Miss Gertrude Dooley and Mrs. Myrtle Evans.

Mr. Dooley was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, in Albany, and a member and past commander of the Amstutz-Marty Post No. 256, American Legion at Monticello. Mr. Dooley was a serviceman for 6 months in 1918, during World War I.

Funeral services will be conducted on Wed., Nov. 23, at 10 a.m., at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Albany. Father August H. Buezli, church pastor, and Father Wilfred Shea, of St. Victor's Catholic Church, in Monroe, will officiate.

Burial will be in the Greenwood Cemetery, Brodhead. Visitation for Mr. Dooley will be on Tues., Nov. 22, after 5 p.m., at the Newcomer Funeral Home, Monroe, where a prayer service will be held at 8 p.m.,
