

**Margaret A. Dooly**  
**Jan. 14, 1892 - Nov. 19, 1968**  
**Mrs. Dooly Stricken at 76**

Mrs. Margaret Dooly, 76, former Monticello resident, died at 1:55 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 19, in White Haven Nursing Home, Old Argyle Road, Monroe. She had resided there since June 12, 1958.

The former Margaret Pratt was born in Mt. Pleasant Township Jan. 14, 1892, a daughter of David and Margaret Doyle Pratt. She was married to John V. Dooly Jan. 24, 1912, at Dayton. They farmed in the Monticello area with the exception of 10 years in Spring Grove Township. Mr. Dooly died July 23, 1956. The former Dooly farm, a mile east of Monticello, is now owned by Gilbert Disch Sr.

Mrs. Dooly was a member of St. Victor's Catholic Church of Monroe.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Rudy W. (Alice) Ammon, Route 3, Monroe; a son, David, Beloit; a sister, Mrs. Henry J. Disch, and a brother, Van Pratt, both of Janesville; 11 grandchildren, and 28 great-grandchildren.

A son, Gerald Dooly, died April 30, 1961, in Janesville.

Funeral services will be at 10 a.m. Friday, Nov. 22, in St. Victor's Church. Rev. Lawrence J. Kieffer is to officiate. Burial will be in the Dayton Catholic Cemetery, between Belleville and Dayton.
