Lorraine Elmer age 95 of Monroe, formerly of Monticello, died Monday, August 18, 2014 at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe. Lorraine was born September 16, 1918 on the Freitag home farm in Exeter Township, the daughter of Jacob H. and Emma (Jordi) Freitag. She graduated from Monticello High School and married Arnold Elmer on June 10, 1937 in Monticello.
