Arthur A. Escher, 78, N2373 Rapp Road (Okee), Lodi, died Friday, Dec. 7, 1990, at Sauk Prairie Hospital in Prairie du Sac.

He was born March 12, 1912, in Green County, the son of Emil and Emily (Sautter) Escher. He married Eunice Mae Disch Nov. 9, 1935, in Monroe.

He attended Monroe High School. After his marriage he lived in Monticello where he made cheese at the North Side Factory until moving to Lodi in 1962. There he was employed at Alkar until retiring in 1977.

He was an amateur radio operator (HAM) and a member of the American Radio Relay League Inc. and a former member of the Swiss and Limburger Cheesemakers Association.
