

Frank Feldt, Area Farmer, Dies

Frank Feldt, 77, of 722 16th avenue, died at 4 a.m. today, April 17, 1951, at St. Clare hospital.

Mr. Feldt was taken there April 10 following a heart attack and had remained in critical condition until his death this morning.

A farmer in this area for 29 years, he moved to Monroe in 1925. He was preceded in death by his wife in July, 1950.

Born in Sylvester township Oct. 17, 1873, he was the son of August and Minnie Brandt Feldt. He attended schools in the township.

Mr. Feldt was married to Martha Beyer Oct. 1, 1896, in Juda Evangelical church. Mr. and Mrs. Feldt marked their golden wedding anniversary in 1946.

They started their farming career near Albany, then moved to the home farm in Sylvester township for five years. In 1904 they purchased the farm of the late August Feldt in Mt. Pleasant township near Monticello and remained there until their retirement in 1925.

He leaves three sons, William, Beloit, Roy, Monroe, and Earl, Mt. Pleasant; one daughter, Mrs. Ray Van Sickle, Rockford; three brothers, August, Monroe, and Edward and John, Evansville; two sisters, Mrs. Herman Ladwig, Monroe, and Mrs. Emma Luchsinger, Evansville: 11 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Feldt was preceded in death by one brother, Fred, and his parents.

Services will be held at the Immanuel church at 2 p.m. Thursday. The body will be taken from the Stuessy funeral home to the church at 10 a. m. Thursday. Mr. Feldt also. was a member of the Faithful Workers Sunday school class.

Rev. Howard L. Orians will officiate and burial will be in Greenwood cemetery.
