Rites Held for Mrs. Frank Feldt, Monroe

Former Mt. Pleasant Twp. Resident Dies Sunday After Long Illness

Monroe—Funeral services for Mrs. Frank Feldt, 78, who died Sunday at her home here after a long illness, were held at 2 p. m. Wednesday in Immanuel Evangelical United Brethren church.

The Rev. Howard L. Orians, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery.

Mrs. Feldt, the former Martha Beyer, was born in Germany on June 2, 1872. She came to the United States with her parents in 1880.

She was married Oct. 1, 1896, and the couple farmed in Albany, Sylvester and Mt. Pleasant townships, retiring and moving from their Mt. Pleasant township farm to Monroe in 1925.

She was a member of the Immanuel church and its Faithful Workers Sunday school class.

Survivors include her husband; three sons, William, Beloit, Earl, Mt. Pleasant township, and Roy, Monroe, carrier on rural route No. 1 out of Monticello; a daughter, Mrs. Ray Sickel, Rockford, Ill.; a brother, Orlo, Albany; 11 grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren.
