

Myrtle A. Feldt

Nov. 29, 1913 – Sept. 7, 1977

Mrs. Earl J. Feldt, 63, Monticello, died unexpectedly this morning at 6:55 in St. Clare Hospital where she had been admitted yesterday.

Mrs. Feldt was the former Myrtle A. Hartwig, daughter of Edward W. and Lillian Asmus Hartwig. She was born in Juda on Nov. 29, 1913. She graduated from Juda High School and took nurses training at the old Deaconess Hospital in Monroe. She did private duty nursing in this area before her marriage.

She was married Nov. 28, 1935, in the old Juda Hall to Earl J. Feldt. After their marriage they lived in Juda six years and in 1941 moved to Mt. Pleasant Township where they farmed until retiring to Monticello in 1967.

Mrs. Feldt is survived by her husband; two daughters, Mrs. Robert (Donna) W. Durtschi and Mrs. Arthur (Nancy) Studer Jr., Rt. 1, both of Monticello; and five grandchildren.

Mrs. Feldt was preceded in death by a brother, Lawrence Hartwig, Juda, who died in 1959; her father on Feb. 1, 1968; and her mother on April 9, 1969.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, its Faith Circle, the Grace Mission Circle and the Monticello Christian Women's Association. She had been teaching a weekly class in Bible studies in Monticello.

Services will be Saturday, Sept. 10, at 1:30 p.m. in the Zwingli United Church of Christ. Rev. Charles G. Workman will officiate. Interment will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
