

## **Keith R. Field**

MONTICELLO — Keith R. Field, 41, 545 So. Main St., Monticello, died Saturday, Aug. 18, 1984 at St. Clare Hospital in Monroe following an extended illness.

He was born May 11, 1943 in Monroe, the son of Clyde and Ruth (Skattum) Field. He was a 1961 graduate of Monticello High School. He married Janet M. Boss on May 17, 1964 at the Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello.

Mr. Field was employed by Standard Oil Co. for four years and since 1967 has been the purchasing agent at Oaktron Industries in Monroe. He was a member of the Zwingli UCC; a 19 year member of the Monticello Fire Department and was secretary and treasurer of the Monroe City Bowling league for a number of years.

L. (Christine) Turner Jr., all of Monticello. He was preceded in death by his father who died July 15, 1974.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 pm. Tuesday at Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello where the Rev. Charles J. Workman officiated.

A solo, "The Old Rugged Cross," was sung by William L. Robbins who was accompanied by George Grenzow on the organ. The congregation sang "How Great Thou Art." Following cremation, interment was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
