Final Rites are Held For Mrs. J. H. Figi Former Local Resident is Called in Hospital Sunday Night

Funeral services for Mrs. J. Henry Figi, aged 75, New Glarus, and a former Monticello resident, who passed away Sunday night in the Monroe hospital, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church here.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

The former Myrtle Lemon, she was born in Washington township Aug. 28, 1875, the daughter of William and Rebeka Willis Lemon. In 1893 she was united in marriage to J. Henry Figi. Mr. and Mrs. Figi made their home in Monticello for a number of years, during which time Mr. Figi was a foreman for the Green county highway department. They moved to a farm near Brooklyn 28 years ago, Mr. Figi passed away in 1949 and for the past year Mrs. Figi and her daughter, Loraine Figi, had made their home in New Glarus.

Surviving are the daughter; and two brothers, William Lemon, Monroe, and Jesse Lemon, Monticello.
