Mrs. Zoe Foster, 82, 307 S. Garfield St., Port Washington, formerly of Monticello, died Friday, Dec. 14, at St. Joseph's Hospital in West Bend.

She was born Jan. 4, 1897, at Monticello, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Hancock.

On June 20, 1917, she was married to Earl (Pop) Foster of Roberts. The couple moved to Port Washington in 1932. He died November 18, 1960. Mrs. Foster was secretary of the American Legion Auxiliary for 40 years, a member of the Port Washington Women's Club, and served as the Blood Bank chairman for many years. Survivors include three daughters, Mrs. Elmer (Audrey) Zell of West Bend, Mrs. Frank (Naomi) Vastola of Buffalo, N.Y., and Mrs. Walt (Joan) Reindl of Mason City, Iowa; three sons, Rex, of Whitewater, Roger of Eagle River, and Earl of Waukegan, Ill.; 14 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

Two grandsons preceded her in death.

Funeral services were held Monday at First Congregational Church, Port Washington. The Rev. James Liebnow, pastor, officiated. Burial was in Union Cemetery.
