Funeral services for Mrs. J. C. Freitag, 80 years of age, a lifelong resident of Green county, who passed away at her home on Railroad avenue at about 5:30 o'clock on Wednesday evening of last week following a short illness with pneumonia, were conducted at 2 Friday afternoon in the home.

Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, officiated. Burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were: J. W. Barlow, cashier of the Bank of Monticello, of which the deceased husband is president, John Dick, W. A. Loveland, and Nick Freitag, directors of the bank, Laurance G. Marty and Dan Wichser.

Had Enjoyed Good Health

Mrs. Freitag had always enjoyed good health and for the past several years was well and active despite her advanced years. On Sunday of last week she contracted pneumonia which proved to be too stubborn for medical officials to cure, She continued to weaken until last Wednesday afternoon when she passed into the great beyond.

New Glarus Native

Mary Hoesly was born in New Glarus March 4, 1859, the daughter of John and Anna Hoesly. She received her education in a rural school near the village in which she was born. In 1885 she was united in marriage to John C. Freitag, the ceremony taking place in New Glarus. Following their marriage the couple followed the vocation of farming, settling in Exeter township, where they continued to reside until moving to Monticello in 1904.

Mrs. Freitag was a member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

The deceased is survived by the widower and one sister, Mrs. Rose Kundert, Madison. Mrs. Freitag was preceded in death by the parents and one sister.
