Edward J. Gmur, 80, former Monticello resident, died Thursday, Sept. 23, 1982, in the New Glarus Home, where he had resided since May 20.

He was born in Etna, Pa., on March 22, 1902, the son of John and Anna Kessler Gmur. He came, with his parents, to New Glarus Township when he was a small boy. He attended Meadow Valley rural school. On June 17, 1924, he was married to Alma Voegeli in Zwingli Church parsonage, Monticello. They farmed in the New Glarus area until retiring in Monticello in 1979.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Sept. 25, in the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge, Monticello. Rev. Robert F. Klepper, New Glarus officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
